Presented by Representative BEAR of Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 05/11/17. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 05/30/17.
