Original Title: An Act To Establish the Crimes of Criminal Forced Labor and Aggravated Criminal Forced Labor in the Maine Criminal Code. Final Disposition: Enacted, PUBLIC LAW, Chapter 416. (Veto Overridden 05/02/18).
