Original Title: An Act To Establish as a Class D Crime the Intentional Photographing of a Minor Without Consent of the Minor's Parent or Guardian by an Individual Required To Register as a Sex Offender. New Title: An Act To Protect Children Under 14 Years of Age from Being Photographed by Certain Persons. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative POULIOT of Augusta. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. Public Hearing 02/26/18. Amended by: CA (Changed Title) H-656. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 04/02/18, PUBLIC LAW, Chapter 354.
