Resolve, To Require the Construction of a New District Headquarters Building for the Bureau of Forestry in Fort Kent. Presented by President JACKSON of Aroostook. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. Public Hearing 03/19/19. Majority (OTP-AM) Report Accepted 05/16/19. Amended by: CA S-94, SA/CA S-335. Finally Passed, Held by Governor 07/02/19. Pursuant to Joint Order (SP 704), recalled from Governor's Desk. Final Disposition: Died Upon Conclusion of the 129th Legislature 11/16/20.
