Presented by Representative WHITE of Waterville. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Veterans and Legal Affairs. Public Hearing 04/08/19. OTP-AM Accepted 05/02/19. Amended by: CA H-163, HA H-344. Final Disposition: Finally Passed, CONSTITUTIONAL RESOLUTION, Chapter 1. Approved at Referendum 11/05/19 (In favor: 141,162; Opposed: 45,799).
