Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 01/21/20. Majority (OTP-AM) Report Accepted 03/10/20. Amended by: CA H-696. Final Disposition: Died Upon Conclusion of the 129th Legislature 11/16/20.
