An Act To Reclassify Certain Offenses under the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Laws and Motor Vehicle Laws and Increase the Efficiency of the Criminal Justice System. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative WARREN of Hallowell. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. Public Hearing 02/19/20. Final Disposition: Died Upon Conclusion of the 129th Legislature 11/16/20.
