Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 01/10/24. Majority (OTP-AM) Report Accepted 03/28/24. Amended by: CA H-853, HA/CA H-899. Carried Over: 07/26/23. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 04/12/24, PUBLIC LAW, Chapter 620.
