An Act to Address the Recent Mill Closure in the Town of Jay by Providing Funds to Offset Property Tax Loss. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative LYMAN of Livermore Falls. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 05/30/23. Majority (OTP-AM) Report Accepted 06/21/23. Final Disposition: Died On Adjournment 07/26/23.
