An Act to Amend the Law Governing the Disposition of Forfeited Firearms. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.)

Presented by Senator CARNEY of Cumberland. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 03/05/24. Majority (OTP-AM) Report Accepted 04/16/24.

Amended by: CA S-679. Final Disposition: Enacted. (Veto Sustained 05/10/24).
