An Act to Repeal the Acts Consolidated in the Revised Statutes of the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Maine:

Sec. 1. The public acts, passed during the years hereinafter named and herein designated, are repealed except so far as they are hereinafter preserved or excepted; but no other acts or parts of acts are repealed.

All the chapters of the revised statutes of the year nineteen hundred sixteen, numbered one to one hundred forty-eight inclusive, except chapter seventy-five, entitled "The Insolvent Law."

The chapters three hundred nineteen and three hundred fifty of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred fifteen, the chapters one to three hundred six, both inclusive, of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred seventeen, the chapters one to two hundred thirty-nine both inclusive, of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred nineteen, the chapters two hundred forty to two hundred sixty-four, both inclusive, of the public laws enacted at the special session of the year nineteen hundred nineteen, the chapters two hundred sixty-five to two hundred sixty-eight, both inclusive, of the public laws enacted at the special session of the year nineteen hundred twenty, the chapters one to two hundred twentyfive, both inclusive, of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred twenty-three, the chapters one to two hundred fifteen, both inclusive, of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred twenty-five, the chapters one to two hundred sixty-three, both inclusive, of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred twenty-seven, except such of said acts and parts of acts as have heretofore been repealed, and except such of said acts and parts of acts as have not been substantially incorporated in the revision of the statutes and are not inconsistent therewith.

Sec. 2. All the chapters and parts of chapters designated as private and special laws of the years 1917 to 1927 inclusive which may have been substantially incorporated in the revision of the statutes are repealed; but no other such acts or parts of acts are repealed.

Sec. 3. The repeal of the acts and parts of acts aforesaid does not revive any of the acts repealed by them. Acts of incorporation declared to be public acts are not repealed, and any other act granting special rights or franchises of a kind usually classified as private and special, although designated as a public law, is not repealed except as provided in section two hereof. The acts declared to be repealed remain in force for the trial and punishment of all past violations of them; and for the recovery of penalties or forfeitures already incurred; and for the preservation of all rights and their remedies existing by virtue of them; and so far as they apply to any office, trust, judicial proceeding, right, contract, limitation, or event, already affected by them.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect on the day of nineteen hundred and
