STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE ACTS CONSOLIDATED IN THE REVISED STATUTES OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

- SEC. 1. List of repealed acts.
2. Repeal of repealing acts not to revive acts before repealed. Acts of incorporation declared public not repealed. Acts repealed to remain in force for certain purposes.
 3. Enumeration of certain acts not included in the revision, not repealed.
 4. Time of act taking effect, January 1, 1858.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SEC. 1. The public acts passed during the years hereafter named and herein designated are repealed, except so far as they are preserved or excepted in the two following sections: Enumeration of the repealed acts.

1840. All the chapters of the revised statutes, numbered one to one hundred and seventy-eight.

1840. An act in relation to elections.

1841. An act to amend the revised statutes, with all the chapters numbered one to eleven.

1842. Chapters numbered one to forty.

1843. Chapters numbered one to thirty-nine.

1844. Chapters numbered eighty to one hundred and twenty-nine.

1845. Chapters numbered one hundred and thirty to one hundred and seventy-four.

1846. Chapters numbered one hundred and seventy-five to two hundred and twenty-six.

1847. Chapters numbered one to thirty-four.

1848. Chapters numbered thirty-five to ninety.

1849. Chapters numbered ninety-one to one hundred and fifty-one.

1850. Chapters numbered one hundred and fifty-two to two hundred and seven.

1851. Chapters numbered two hundred and eight to two hundred and seventeen.

1852. Chapters numbered two hundred and eighteen to two hundred and ninety-five.

1853. Chapters numbered one to fifty-four.

1854. Chapters numbered fifty-five to one hundred and ten.

1855. Chapters numbered one hundred and eleven to one hundred and eighty-nine.

1856. Chapters numbered one hundred and ninety to two hundred and seventy-nine, except chapter two hundred and fifty-five, and an act to preserve the harbor of the city of Portland. Inclusive of all the numbers named.

1857. Chapters numbered one, two, three, four, six, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, twenty, twenty-one, twenty-three, twenty-four, twenty-five, twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-one, thirty-two, thirty-three, thirty-four, thirty-five, thirty-six, thirty-seven, thirty-eight, thirty-nine, forty, forty-two, forty-three, forty-four, forty-five, forty-six, forty-seven, forty-eight, forty-nine, fifty-one, fifty-three, fifty-four, fifty-five, fifty-six, fifty-seven, fifty-eight, and fifty-nine.

Acts before repealed not revived, acts of incorporation declared public not repealed, acts repealed, in force for certain purposes.

SEC. 2. The repeal of the acts aforesaid does not revive any of the acts repealed by them. Acts of incorporation declared to be public acts are not repealed. The acts declared to be repealed remain in force for the trial and punishment of all past violations of them; and for the recovery of penalties or forfeitures already incurred; and for the preservation of all rights and their remedies existing by virtue of them; and so far as they apply to any office, trust, judicial proceeding, right, contract, limitation, or event, already affected by them.

Acts not included in revision, not repealed.

SEC. 3. The following described acts and parts of acts are not included in the revised statutes of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, and are not thereby repealed:

All acts respecting the establishment and the bounds of counties, districts, and towns.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight.
