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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

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AN ACT

TO REVISE AND CONSOLIDATE THE PUBLIC LAWS OF THE STATE.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN LEGISLATURE ASSEMBLED, in the manner stated under the several titles and chapters as follows, not including head notes or marginal notes or references:

The foregoing act, from chapter one to one hundred and forty-three, both inclusive, shall take effect and become law from and after the first day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one.

IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, January 24, 1871.
