## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTEEN.

### AN ACT

TO REVISE AND CONSOLIDATE THE PUBLIC LAWS OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MAINE, in the manner stated under the several titles and chapters, not including abstracts of sections, notes, or references:

The foregoing act, from chapter one to chapter one hundred and fortyeight, both inclusive, shall take effect and become law on the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventeen.

IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, Sept. 29, 1916. This bill, including chapters one to one hundred and forty-eight, inclusive, having had three several readings, passed to be enacted.
