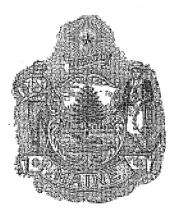

# NOTE

In accordance with the Resolve of April 4, 1913, authorizing the sixth revision of the public laws of the state, the provisions of law relating to the national guard, which were omitted from all revisions since 1857, have been included in the Revised Statutes under the title "The Military Law." The index of that title has been prepared by Reuel W. Smith, Esq. of the Androscoggin Bar, and will be found in its alphabetical order. In the classification of the index under that title, the subdivisions of the text of the law as found in chapter fifteen have, in the main, been followed. To avoid unnecessarily increasing the volume of the index, references to that chapter have not generally been inserted under secondary titles, but in place thereof numerous cross references to the leading title, The Military Law, have been inserted.
