1351. Breeding and raising mink.

§ 1351. Breeding and raising mink

Mink that have been propagated in captivity for 2 or more generations shall be considered domesticated animals subject to all the laws of the State with reference to possession, ownership and taxation as are at any time applicable to domesticated animals. Such domesticated mink, the pelts or products thereof shall be deemed agricultural products and the breeding, raising, producing in captivity and marketing thereof shall be deemed an agricultural pursuit. Any person, firm or corporation engaged in breeding and raising mink shall be licensed under Title 12, section 2106.
