2551. Bee inspectors.

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§ 2551. Bee inspectors

The commissioner shall employ one or more persons qualified by experience and knowledge in beekeeping as inspectors of apiaries, who shall serve during the pleasure of the commissioner.

§ 2552. —Salary

Bee inspectors shall be employed on a per diem basis and shall receive necessary traveling expenses while actually engaged in the performance of their duties.

§ 2553. —Duties

Bee inspectors shall make such inspection of the apiaries throughout the State as the commissioner may deem necessary to determine the presence therein of bee diseases of an infectious or contagious nature.

§ 2554. Access to apiaries

Such inspectors shall have the authority to enter at all reasonable times upon the premises of any keeper of bees and make such examination of the bees, equipment and appliances found thereon as he may deem necessary to determine the presence of contagious or infectious diseases.
