**§ 2651. Public nuisance**

All bees infected with the disease known as American Foulbrood, together with the equipment and appliances contaminated thereby, are declared to be a public nuisance and may be abated as provided in Title 17, section 2706.

**§ 2652. Diseased bees or equipment**

It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly own or possess bees having any contagious or infectious disease, or bee equipment and appliances contaminated thereby. It shall be unlawful to sell, barter or give away bees, equipment or appliances from any apiary without a certificate of inspection from a bee inspector.
