**CHAPTER 23****ROLLER-SKATING RINKS**

601. License required.

602. Hours.

**§ 601. License required**

Every person who keeps a roller-skating rink or room shall obtain a license from the municipal officers of the city or town where such rink is located and shall pay therefor such sum as said municipal officers may deem proper. Any person keeping a roller-skating rink without such license shall be punished by a fine of \$10 for each day it is so kept.

**§ 602. Hours**

Every person licensed under section 601 shall keep such rink closed between 10 o'clock in the evening and sunrise, unless express permission in writing to keep it open a longer time is obtained from the municipal officers of the city or town where such rink is located. Any person violating this section shall be punished by a fine of \$10 for every such offense.
