

CHAPTER 5

ADULTERY

Sec.

101. Penalty; cohabitation after divorce.

§ 101. Penalty; cohabitation after divorce

Whoever commits adultery shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 5 years. When only one of the parties is married, or when they have been legally divorced from the bonds of matrimony and afterwards cohabit, each shall be deemed guilty of adultery.
