

CHAPTER 109

ROBBERY

3401. Definition.

3402. Assault with intent.

§ 3401. Definition

Whoever, by force and violence or by putting in fear, feloniously steals and takes from the person of another property that is the subject of larceny is guilty of rcbbery and shall be punished by imprisonment for any term of years.

R.S.1954, c. 130, § 16.

§ 3402. Assault with intent

Whoever assaults another with intent to rob or steal, if armed with a dangerous weapon, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than 20 years; when not so armed, by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 10 years.
