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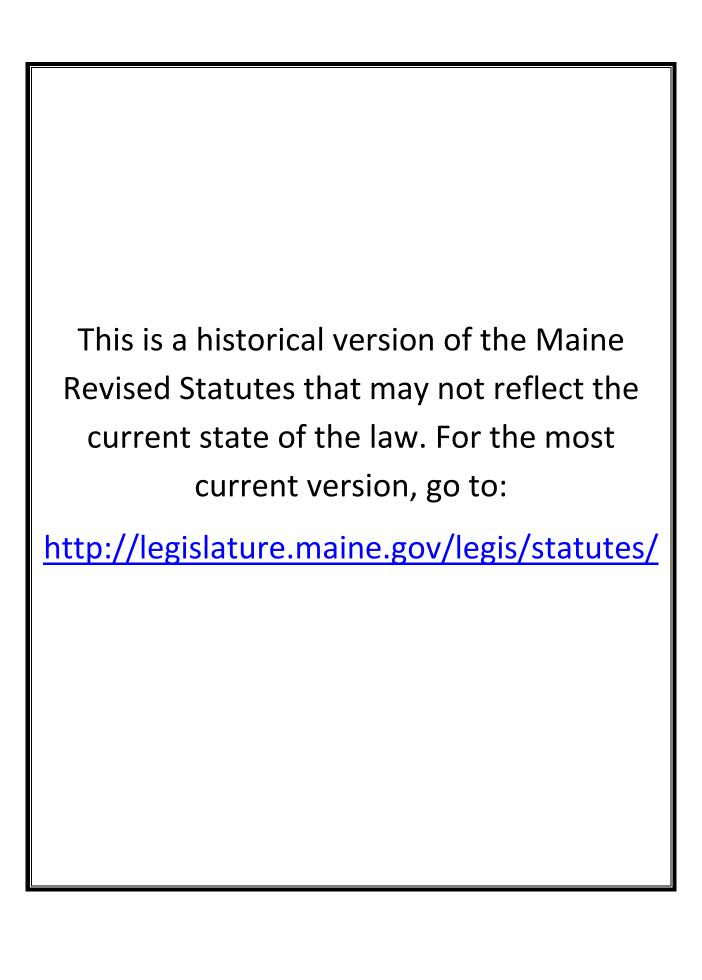

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§ 251. Information for department on request

In order to afford the department better advantages for obtaining knowledge important to be incorporated with that collected through special investigations and from other sources, all officers of the State, the physicians of all incorporated companies and the president or agent of any company chartered, organized or transacting business under the laws of this State, as far as practicable, shall furnish to the department any information bearing upon public health which may be requested by said department for the purpose of enabling it better to perform its duties of collecting and distributing useful knowledge on this subject.

§ 252. Penalties

Whoever willfully violates any provision of sections 451, 454 to 456, 460 to 462, 904, 905, 951 to 954, 961 to 963, 1001 to 1004 and 1010, or of said regulations and bylaws, or neglects or refuses to obey any order or direction of any local health officer authorized by said provisions, the penalty for which is not specifically provided, or willfully interferes with any person or thing to prevent the execution of said sections or of said regulations and bylaws shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by both. The District Court shall have jurisdiction, original and concurrent with the Superior Court, of all offenses under said sections.
