STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT authorizing the taxation of equitable interests in real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whenever any person or persons shall

- 2 by virtue of any writing, contract, bond or obligation,
- 3 have the right of redeeming any real estate, or by
- 4 paying any sum by virtue of said writing, contract,
- 5 bond or obligation, may be entitled to demand and
- 6 receive a deed of any real estate, or may have any
- 7 equitable interest in and to any real estate by virtue
- 8 of any writing, contract, bond or obligation, the same

- 9 shall be subject to taxation in the city, town or plan-10 tation in which the said land shall be situate, to the 11 owner or holder thereof.
 - Sec. 2. Any owner or holder of any equitable in-2 terest, as aforesaid, may make oath as to the amount 3 due and the true value of said interest, in the same 4 manner as persons who present lists of their polls and 5 estate, as is now provided for by law.
- Sec. 3. A lien is hereby created on such equitable 2 interest, for the payment of any tax which may be 3 assessed thereon, as is now by law created on real 4 estate, for the taxes assessed on real estate; and the 5 same may be taken and sold at public auction at any 6 time after the expiration of one year from the date 7 of assessment, in the same way that equities of mort-8 gaged real estate may be taken and sold on execution, 9 and the same rights of redemption shall exist as is 10 provided for the redemption of equities of mortgaged 11 real estate, sold on execution.
