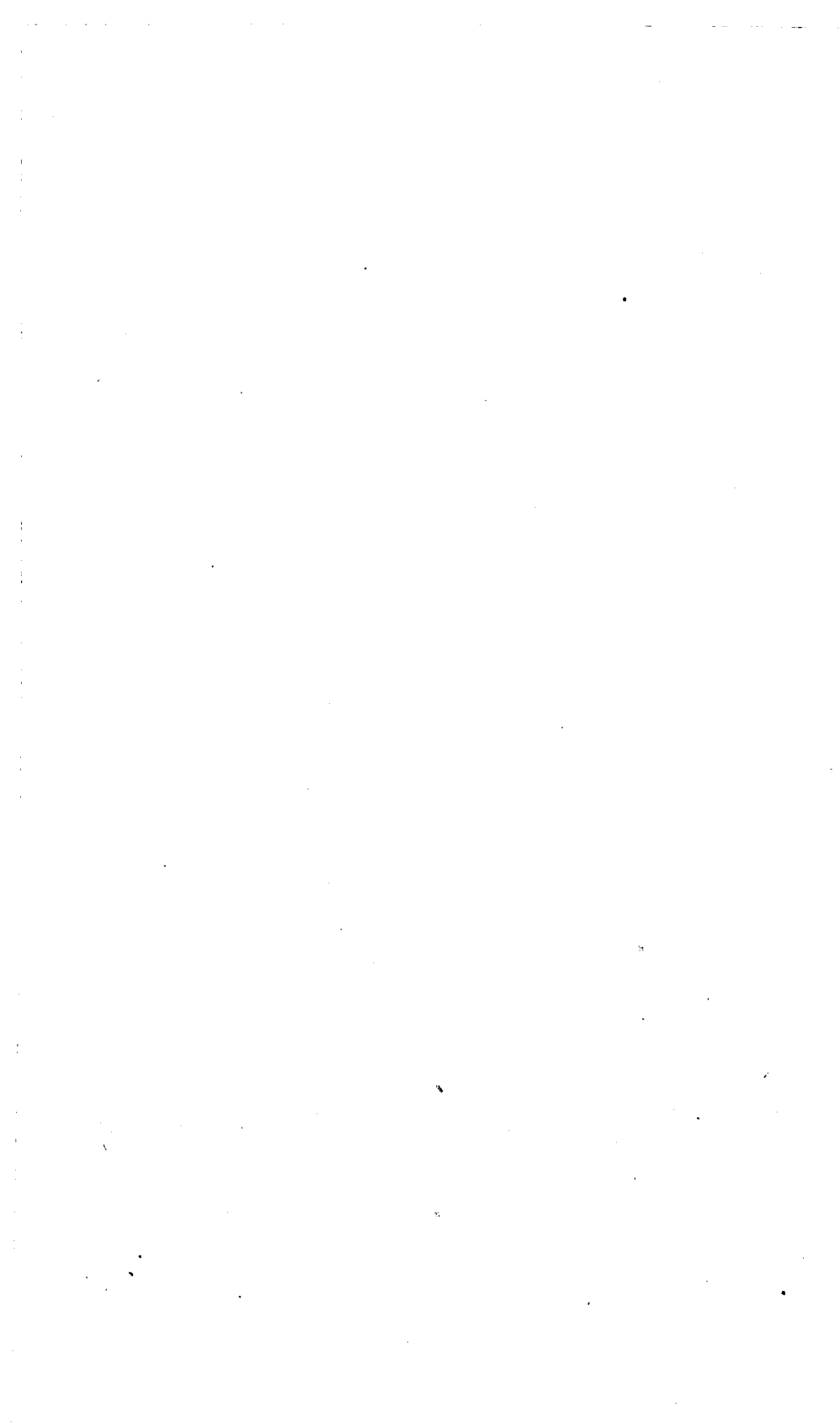

# REPORT.

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LAND OFFICE, December 31, 1858.

*To the Governor and Council of Maine :*

In compliance with the requisitions of law, I have the honor to submit this, my annual report, which, with the accounts, the schedules and tables annexed, will exhibit the operations of the land department the current year.

Since my last annual report, I have, in accordance with the provisions of the 5th chapter of the Revised Statutes, made and submitted to the Governor and Council, quarterly reports of the transactions of this department, and have also returned to the State Treasurer quarterly trial balances, or balance sheets of the Land Office ledger; but as the annual reports only, are required to be printed for the inspection of the Legislature, it will become necessary to recapitulate some of the more important facts already alluded to in the quarterly reports.

## **Map of the Public Lands.**

In compliance with the order of Council, dated June 25, 1858, directing me "to procure for the use of the State, a draft of a map of the northern portion of the State," I procured the services of Luther H. Eaton, Esq., of Bangor, as draftsman, whose work will be completed and ready for inspection, at or about the time of the meeting of the Legislature.

In the execution of this map, Mr. Eaton has spared no pains in collecting all the materials and information necessary to the production of a work of this kind, and it is believed that a map so well and faithfully executed, cannot fail of meeting the expectation and wants of the public.

### Survey of the State Line.

Under the "Resolve providing for surveying and marking the State line between Maine and New Hampshire," approved March 23, 1858, I appointed John M. Wilson, Esq., of Oxford County, as surveyor on the part of Maine, to co-operate with Henry O. Kent, Esq., of Lancaster, the surveyor on the part of New Hampshire, with directions to prosecute the survey in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid resolve. The field work of this survey was completed in the early part of October last. The report of the surveyors has been returned; but their accounts on the part of Maine, have not, as yet, been settled.

### Surveys of Lands for Settlement.

Of the townships set apart for settlement by a resolve of the last Legislature, and by an order of Council, dated July 2, 1858, "recommended to be surveyed for settling purposes," I have caused the following townships and tracts to be surveyed and lotted for that purpose, to wit: No. 5, range three; the balance of G, range two; a portion of L, range two; east half of 2, range five; south half of 12, range four; and some lots on I, range two. Some few roads have also been located for the convenience of settlers, not only on the foregoing townships, but on C, range one; F, range two; 12 and 13, range three; and 13, range four. These surveys have been executed by P. P. Burleigh, of Linneus; J. E. S. Cony, of Augusta; John Gardner, of Calais; Daniel Barker, of Exeter; Lore Alford, of Old Town; David F. Adams, of Lyndon; and E. Knight, of Fort Fairfield.

The field notes and plans of the survey of 2, R. 5, and 12, R. 4; also of L, R. 2; as made by Messrs. Barker, and Alford, have been duly returned to this office. The returns of the other surveyors are expected within the time required by law.

Under the "Resolve in relation to L, range two," approved March 20, 1858, I employed Hon. J. W. Stinchfield, who had previously explored the township under a former resolve, to direct and assist in setting off to George W. Smith, of Van Buren plantation, six thousand acres, which has accordingly been done, by metes and bounds; and the field notes and plan of the same are embraced in the returns made by Mr. Alford, the surveyor of said township.

### Settlement of the Country, Land Sales, &c.

Looking upon the settlement of the country with a hardy and enduring yeomanry, as an important object to be attained, I have endeavored to afford every aid and facility in my power to promote that object.

To answer more readily the numerous letters of inquiry addressed to this office from all parts of the country, for information relative to our settling lands, I found it necessary to prepare and publish a Circular descriptive of these lands, with the terms and conditions of sale, together with a map of that portion of the State in which lands are offered for settlement. And it is believed that the information thus disseminated has had a salutary influence in turning the attention of the community to the importance of developing the resources of our wilderness lands, where the foundation for good farms, and desirable homes may be obtained "without money," and almost "without price."

The amount of lands conveyed during the year, together with the names of the purchasers, and the consideration for which the conveyances were made, are stated in detail, in the schedules annexed to this report. By a reference to these schedules, it will be seen that the amount of sales to *actual settlers* exceeds that of any previous year since the Massachusetts purchase in 1853, and nearly, if not quite, equals the whole amount sold since that time.

But, as stated in my last annual report, the schedules of lands sold, do not show the actual amount taken up for settlement, as the custom which has so long prevailed of entering upon lots before making application for them at the Land office, has not, as yet, been wholly abandoned. In justice, however, to many of our settling agents for the current year, it is proper to remark that through their exertions, the evils alluded to in my last year's report, have been, to a good extent, remedied.

In discharging the duties of agent, I have endeavored to adhere strictly to the law regulating the sale and settlement of the public lands, and to check, as far as possible, the pernicious practice of "squatting" upon townships before they are surveyed or even designated, or set apart for settlement.

### Unlawful Entry upon Townships for Settlement, Plunder of Timber, &c.

During the past season, an effort was made by certain individuals to enter upon township No. 14, R. 3, which was set apart in 1856, for the benefit of common schools. But as it was not in the market for settlement, I deemed it my duty to prohibit any cuttings on the township, by which the timber upon it might be endangered by *fires* as well as by *trespassers*. I learn, also, that a settler has entered with his family on township No. 11, R. 3, which is not, as yet, in the market for settlement.

The timber on this township was permitted by Massachusetts to J. S. Jenness, till 1861, the stumpage of which, by the terms of the purchase of 1853, belongs to Maine.

This township is in near proximity to Presque Isle, and is reported to be a good tract for settlement; and it may become requisite for the Legislature to set it apart for that purpose.

But if the present laws are not sufficiently effective to protect any and all of the public lands from being thus unlawfully entered upon, before they are lotted, and open for the market, thereby exposing the timber, and rendering the survey of the land more laborious and perplexing,—to say nothing of the conflicting claims which are liable to arise by possessions being thus prematurely made,—then such further legislation should be had as will remedy the evil in future.

### Eaton and Plymouth Grants.

In compliance with the instructions to me directed under the report made in Council, July 2, 1858, on the petition of Joseph B. Hall, "for commissioners to be appointed to examine the townships called Eaton and Plymouth Grants, in the County of Aroostook, for the purpose of purchasing or exchanging lands for the same, belonging to the State; for the benefit of the settlers on said townships," &c., I employed, as my assistant, M. S. Drummond, Esq., and proceeded to said townships and examined them, (as well as a portion of township C, range two, for which an exchange was proposed to be made,) so far as to satisfy ourselves as to their situation and quality, and the number of settlers on said tracts claiming lands under the treaty of Washington, as well as the number of settlers not entitled to claims under the treaty.



These are excellent tracts of land for farming, as good, at least, as any lands in the valley of the Aroostook; and could a purchase be made for cash, or such an exchange be made with the proprietors for other lands, as would be considered equitable, I have no hesitation in saying that, in my opinion, it would very essentially enhance the settlement of that portion of the State to which the current of emigration is now so strongly tending.

We find residing upon the Eaton Grant, thirty-five settlers under the treaty of Washington, to whom were awarded by the commissioners appointed under the resolve of April 12, 1854, 3,062 acres of land; and twenty-five settlers not entitled to claims under the treaty, twenty-three of whom have taken up a lot of 160 acres each, making 3,680 acres.

On the east half of Plymouth Grant, we find sixteen settlers under said treaty, to whom were awarded 1,497 acres by the commissioners aforesaid; and twenty-three not claiming under said treaty, eighteen of whom have taken up lands not lotted for settlement, and on which several good farms are already being made, and upon which families are residing.

On the west half of said Plymouth Grant, we find forty-one settlers under the treaty, to whom were awarded by the commissioners, 3,300 acres; also two making possessions on lands not lotted. On the southerly side of the Aroostook river, a good turnpike road has already been made, and is now in good condition through the entire extent of these two grants, measuring in all, some ten or eleven miles. Two other roads have been located by the proper authorities on the northerly side of said river, one leading northerly from Fort Fairfield to Letter E, range one, (Limestone plantation,) and the other leading along the shore of the river, and connecting the "Eastern Aroostook road," so called, with the settlement at the mouth of Limestone stream in the Province of New Brunswick.

The road first named is very much needed to connect the settlement of E, (Limestone plantation,) with the lower settlements on the State lands; but as the settlers cannot purchase their lands, at present, of the proprietors, either for *road labor* or cash, these settlers, as well as those on the State lands above them, suffer great inconveniences which would be obviated if these lands belonged to the State.

Under the present "settling laws," the State cannot, of course, expect to derive any present *pecuniary* benefit from the purchase of these lands—the only advantage being to promote the settlement of her wilderness lands, and in that way increase the wealth and prosperity of her citizens, by opening fields and channels of labor to the strong-handed, and homes to the destitute.

### Lands Owned in Common with Proprietors.

It may be proper to call the attention of the Legislature to the fact that till 1853, when Maine purchased of Massachusetts the balance of all her lands in this State, a large proportion of these lands had been owned in common and undivided by the two States; and that, a short time previous to that purchase, Maine sold her *undivided half* of certain townships and tracts of these lands to individual proprietors, while the other half was still owned by Massachusetts. Consequently Maine, by purchasing the title of Massachusetts in these lands, became a cotenant or joint owner with the proprietors, and with whom they are still held in common. And although it might be for the interest of the State to own and control her lands in severalty, yet, without some further legislation on the subject, there may be a question as to whose duty it is to cause a partition to be made between the State and the proprietors, as well as to the mode of effecting such partition.

### Expenditures upon Roads and Bridges.

The agents appointed in 1857, to expend the appropriation of \$1,000.00 on the road from the Boundary line to the Allagash river, and whose returns were not made in season to be entered in my last year's report, have made a satisfactory report of their agencies, and their accounts have been examined and allowed.

The following sums have been expended the present year upon roads and bridges under resolves of the Legislature, to wit.:

The agents under whose supervision the aforesaid sums were expended, have made due and satisfactory returns, and their accounts have been audited and allowed.

### Financial Condition of the Land Office.

The amount of securities in the Land office, in notes and bonds, &c., will be shown in the account and schedules annexed. As directed by a resolve of the Legislature, approved March 27, 1858, I have withdrawn from the files in the Land office, certain demands

overdue six years or upwards, and which, in the opinion of the Governor and Council, cannot be collected, amounting to \$13,621 16, a schedule of which was advertised three weeks successively in the State paper, as required by the resolve aforesaid.

It will be seen by the annexed table exhibiting the receipts and disbursements of the Land office during the year, that I have paid into the treasury the sum of \$51,151.95; which includes \$220.16 for sales of timber and grass on lands reserved for public uses. The receipts of the office during the year, have exceeded the amount anticipated in my last year's report; but as the *final payment* required on certain notes, the collection of which was provided for by a resolve of the Legislature of 1856, has now been met, the avails of the office for the ensuing year will probably be considerably less than those of the past. As no permits can be given, under the present statute, to cut timber upon the public lands, that source of revenue cannot, of course, be relied upon, till the law is changed.

As to the notes in the Land office, not embraced under the resolve of 1856, and which were given for lands conveyed by conditional deeds, and now overdue, it remains for the Legislature to determine whether payments shall be enforced, since by the conditions in the deeds, no payments can be relied upon during the year ensuing, except the avails of the timber that may be cut upon the townships for which the notes were given.

### Protection of the Public Lands, &c.

Since the late revision of the general laws, I find no authority for granting permits to cut timber upon the public lands, and have therefore granted none, either written or verbal, during the past year. In order to protect these lands against trespassers, it is found necessary to employ suitable assistants to trace out the lines and streams, and to take possession of the timber cut in violation of law. In former years, this duty was performed principally by men employed by the State to scale the timber cut under permits. This year, as no permits are given, I have, in most cases, made arrangements with such of the scalers on proprietors' lands as were located near the State lands, to look to the lines, and if any trespassing was discovered, to lose no time in giving due notice of the fact to the Land office.

The protection of these lands, interspersed as they are, over an extent of more than ten thousand square miles, requires constant vigilance, and is attended with much trouble and expense. In that part of the State where the timber is most exposed, I have entrusted its supervision to agents appointed expressly for that purpose.

In townships which have been surveyed for settlement, there are certain mile sections that are unfit for settling purposes, the timber upon which is exposed to fires, &c, and, in my opinion, it would be for the interest of the State to authorize the sale of these sections for cash, as well as certain lots in the County of Aroostook, together with the improvements thereon, which were formerly mortgaged to the State, and the mortgages subsequently foreclosed by the State Treasurer.

In the quarterly reports from this department, a full statement in regard to the *timber-cuttings* upon the public lands during the winter of 1857-'58, has already been submitted to the Governor and Council; and in accordance with their advice and direction, a settlement with nearly all the parties named in said reports has been effected, by exacting, in addition to the usual State prices for stumps, an amount sufficient to cover all costs in the suits commenced, and the extra expenses incurred by the State in looking after, and guarding the timber.

That part of the timber which was cut upon lands near the Canada line, by parties living in New Brunswick, still remains at St. John, without a purchaser. This timber is intermixed with a large quantity of other timber cut in Canada, by the same parties. The principal part of that cut on this side of the State line, was taken from townships sold to proprietors, who are responsible for the balance due for the lands, without having recourse to the timber, on which, however, the State still retains its lien for stumpage. For the small amount cut on the public lands, by these provincials, the only responsible persons among the parties, are the suppliers, Messrs. J. and S. Glasier, of Fredericton, who have agreed to pay the amount due the State; and as they are believed to be honorable men, I apprehend no difficulty in effecting a satisfactory settlement.

On examining the records of the Land office, I am unable to find sufficient data, from which to furnish the information required by an order of the Legislature, passed the 24th March, 1858, as the lim-

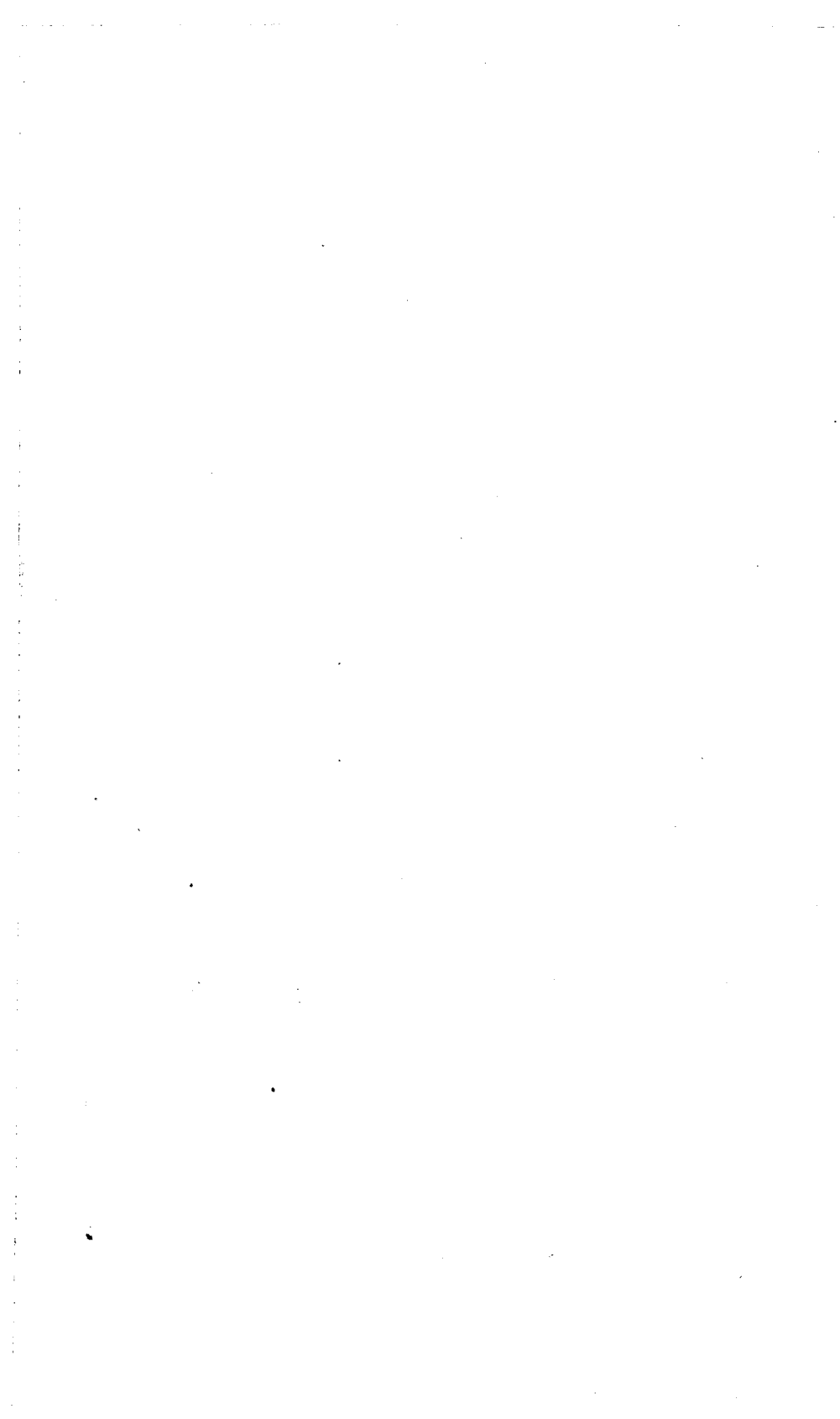
its of the several counties in which expenditures have heretofore been made in aid of roads, bridges, &c., were, in many cases, undefined; and many of the outlays were authorized under appropriations, which were paid by warrants drawn upon the treasury, the accounts of which do not appear in this office.
