STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Wesleyan Seminary and Female Collegiate Institute.

RESOLVED, That the sum of five thousand dollars be and

- 2 hereby is appropriated out of the treasury of the State
- 3 for the use and benefit of the Maine Wesleyan Semi-
- 4 nary and Female Collegiate Institute, to be paid to
- 5 such agent or person as may be duly authorized by
- 6 the trustees of said institution to receive the same;
- 7 provided, however, and this appropriation is upon the
- 8 condition that satisfactory evidence shall be furnished
- 9 to the Governor and Council that a like sum of money
- 10 has been raised for the use of said institution by its
- 11 friends subsequent to the passage of this resolve, and
- 12 whenever this fact shall be made to appear, the Gov-
- 13 ernor shall draw his warrant therefor.

RESOLVED, That the further sum of twenty-five hun2 dred dollars be and hereby is appropriated out of the
3 treasury of the State for the benefit of the Female
4 Collegiate Department of the institution named in the
5 foregoing resolve, to be paid to such agent or person
6 as may be duly authorized by the trustees thereof to
7 receive the same, in one year from the time payment
8 shall be made of the sum appropriated in the preced9 ing resolve; and the said sum of twenty-five hundred
10 dollars when so paid shall be permanently invested in
11 such security or securities as shall appear safe and
12 satisfactory to the Governor and Council, and the
13 income thereof only is to be applied to the current

14 wants of the said Female Collegiate Department of

15 the said institution.
