STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 18, Chapter 82 of the Revised Statutes, relating to brief statements of defence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature nesembled, as follows:

Section 18 of Chapter 82 of the Revised Statutes is

- 2 hereby amended by striking out all of said section
- 3 after the word statement in the fourth line, so that
- 4 said section as amended shall read, as follows:
- 5 "Sect. 18. The general issue may be pleaded in
- 6 all cases, and a brief statement of special matter of
- 7 defence filed, or a special plea, or on leave double pleas
- 8 in bar, may be filed. The plaintiff must join a gen-
- 9 eral issue, and may file a counter brief statement."
