At the request of the House of Representatives, I give below the amounts paid each member of the Executive Council during the years 1856, 1857 and 1858 :

Included in the above are \$18 paid to H. Strickland, "as Committee on the State Prison, and \$20 for visiting State Prison;" to A. S. Holden, \$20 "for visiting State Prison;" to A. Grover, \$20, for visiting State Prison, and to William McLoon, \$10, for same; to J. C. Madigan, \$30, for services in procuring the perfection of the records of the Governor and Council for 1853, and to A. Grover, \$573 "for services at Washington." With these exceptions, the sums paid are for the travel and attendance of the members at the sessions of the Board.

In the above are \$23* paid to each member "for travel to visit the Reform School, State Arsenal, and State Prison," and the balance is for travel and attendance at the sessions of the Council.

There is included in the above the sum of \$23 paid to each member for "travel to visit Reform School and State Prison;" \$68 to A. A. Wing, for services and expenses as member of Committee on Enlargement and Repair of State Prison, and \$45 as member of Committee to visit the Institution for Dead and Dumb at Hartford, Connecticut, and the Perkins' Institute, at South Boston; \$42,49 to George Pierce for similar services and expenses; \$41,29 to D. L. Milliken, for services and expenses as Committee on Enlargement and Repair of Prison; and \$14,88 to William Merriam, for similar services and expenses; and \$35 to William M. Reed, for services, travel and expenses, under appointment, statedly to visit the Prison. With these deductions, the above sums are for the travel and attendance of the members at their sessions.
