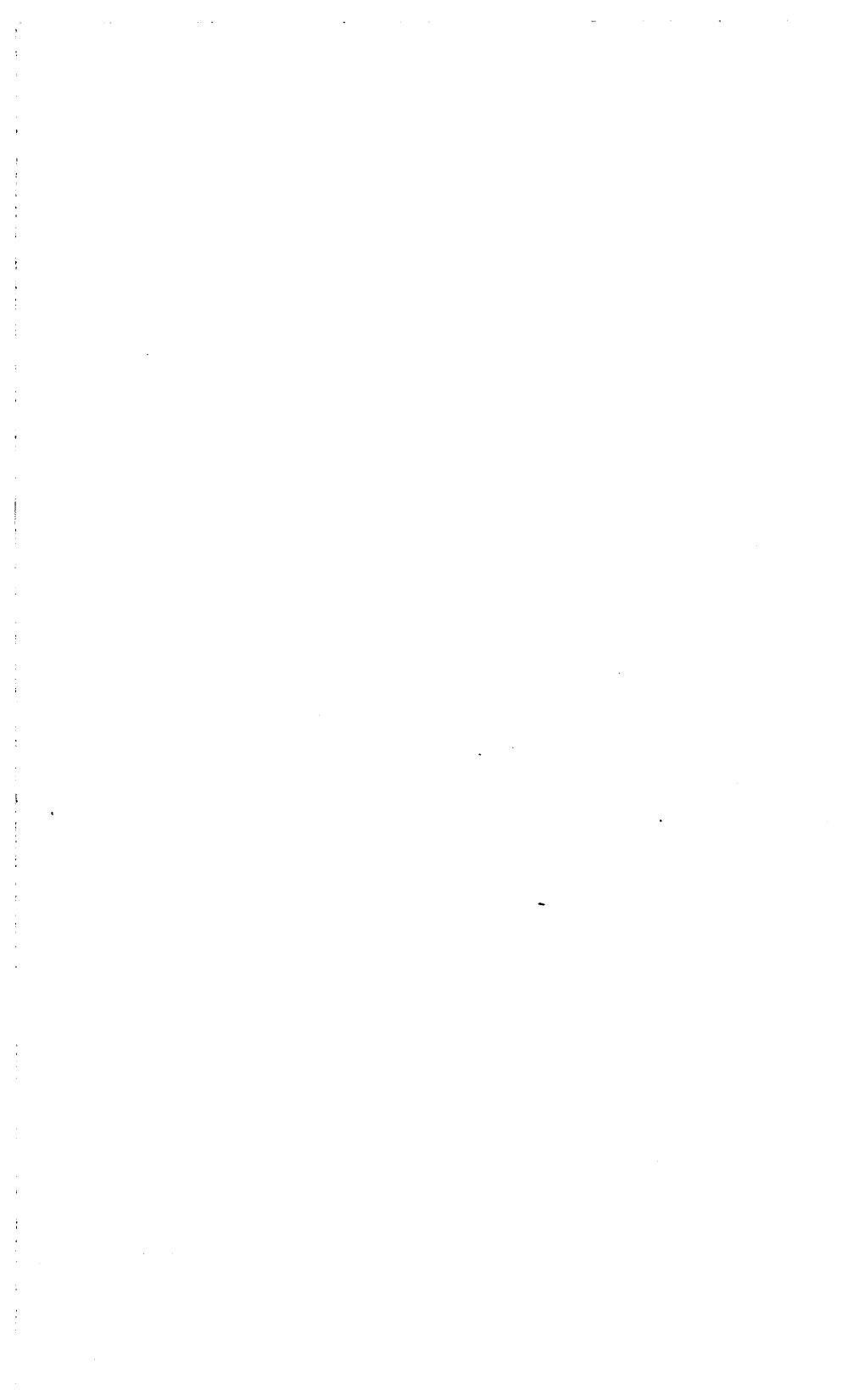
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighty-eight of the Re-
vised Statutes, relating to partition of real estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Whenever it shall appear from the
2 pleadings, that one or more respondents claim to be
3 seized of the whole of a specific parcel of the prem-
4 ises of which partition is prayed, such respondent or
5 respondents shall be entitled to a separate and inde-
6 pendent trial, and the jury shall pass upon such claim
7 without any other being submitted to them at the same
8 time for their determination.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on its approval
by the governor.
