#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to guardians.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section three of chapter sixty-seven of
- 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to the
- 3 end of the section the words following: "but the
- 4 judge of probate may, in any case when he shall deem
- 5 it for the welfare of the minor, decree that the care of
- 6 the person, and the education of the minor, be com-
- 7 mitted to the guardian until the further order of the
- 8 judge."
