#### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The sixth specification of section fifty-five of chapter

- 2 eighty-six of the revised statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out of said specification all after the word
- 4 "children," and inserting in lieu thereof the following
- 5 words, "which amount shall not exceed the sum of
- 6 twenty dollars, and which shall not be exempt in any
- 7 suit for necessaries furnished him or his family," so that
- 8 said specification as amended shall read: "sixth-by
- 9 reason of any amount due from him to the principal

- 10 defendant as wages for his personal labor, or that of
- 11 his wife or minor children; which amount shall not
- 12 exceed the sum of twenty dollars, and which shall not
- 13 be exempt in any suit for necessaries furnished him or
- 14 his family."
