#### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to gradual emancipation of slaves in the northern slave states.

Whereas, It appears by proceedings in the disunion-

- 2 ists' convention at Montgomery, that an attempt is
- 3 being made to coerce the northern slave states into
- 4 joining said confederation, by prohibiting the inter-
- 5 state slave trade; therefore,

Resolved, That our commissioners in the convention

- 2 at Washington be requested, in behalf of the State of
- 3 Maine, to submit a proposition to said convention, pro-
- 4 viding for the peaceful and gradual emancipation of
- 5 slaves in said states, by purchase of the slaves therein.
