AMENDMENTS.

Mr. RAMSDELL'S Amendments to bill "An act to aid the Bangor and Piscataquis Railroad Company, and promote the settlement of the public lands":

Amend by inserting after "payment" in the fourth

- 2 line, the words "or lawfully bargained or contracted
- 3 for, or held under claim of possession and improve-
- 4 ment, or which may be reserved, or are set apart for
- 5 public schools."

Also, after the word "purpose" in the 7th line, the

- 2 words "except that the land agent shall, as hereto-
- 3 fore, in the manner provided by law, select out of
- 4 townships located and designated for settlement, or to
- 5 be located or designated as heretofore, and offer the
- 6 same in lots for settlement, and sell lands to settlers
- 7 and for the purposes of settlement, upon the same
- 8 terms and conditions as he is now authorized by law
- 9 to do."

Section 3d, line 11, after "unsold," the words 2 "except such as are by law reserved for settling pur-3 poses."

Section 4, 9th line, after the word "unsold," the 2 words "except such as are by law reserved for settling 3 purposes."
