
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT relative to the time of commencing and maintaining an action on an award of referees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. An action may be commenced and main-
- 2 tained on an award of referees, at any time within
- 3 twenty years next after the date of making the award,
- 4 instead of the time now allowed by law.
- Sect. 2. This act takes effect when approved by the 2 governor.
