STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT in addition to chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. An inventory returnable by an executor
- 2 or administrator who resides in a town or place other
- 3 than that where the probate court is held, may be
- 4 sworn to before the judge or a justice of the peace.
 - SECT. 2. After an order is passed for the distribu-
- 2 tion of insolvent estates amongst creditors whose claims
- 3 have been proved, the judge of probate may, without
- 4 further notice, audit and allow the account of the ex-

- 5 ecutor or administrator for payments made pursuant to 6 said order.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall apply to inventories return-
- 2 able by guardians, and to accounts of guardians of
- 3 insolvent wards, for payments made to creditors of
- 4 such wards under a like order of distribution.
