## FORTIETH LEGISLATURE.

## STATE OF MAINE,

RESOLVE in favor of the Megantic road in Oxford county.

Resolved, That for the construction of the Megantic 2 road from Wilson's mills in Lincoln plantation, in said 3 county, as located by the county commissioners, pass4 ing through township No. 5, range 2, No. 5, range 3, 5 No. 5, range 4, No. 5, range 5, and No. 4, range 5, 6 to the national boundary, a distance of about twenty7 five miles, there is hereby granted upon the conditions 8 and for the purposes herein named, the proceeds of the 9 sale of three thousand acres of land in No. 5, range 5, 10 and eleven thousand acres in No. 4, range 5, in said 11 county, being the whole quantity of state land unap12 propriated in such townships, more or less, and the 13 land agent is directed to sell said land when he can

14 obtain a fair price for it, and the money received there15 for, he shall pay into the treasury of 0xford county, 16 to be applied in payment for constructing said road; 17 provided the whole of said road shall be constructed to 18 the satisfaction of the land agent within three years.
