STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional in regard to the European and North
American Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The European and North American Rail-
- 2 way Company is hereby authorized to extend its line
- 3 to the boundary of this state at such point or place as
- 4 will best connect with the line of the European and
- 5 North American Railway Company of New Brunswick,
- 6 with the right to extend a branch line to Houlton and
- 7 to the St. John river at the boundary.
 - SECT. 2. It shall be lawful for said European and
- 2 North American Railway Company to issue stock or

- 3 bonds with coupons for interest payable in London, or
- 4 any other place, in, or beyond the limits of this state,
- 5 and it shall be lawful for said Company to extend its
- 6 line to the village of Woodstock; provided, authority
- 7 therefor be granted by the authorities of said province
- 8 of New Brunswick.
 - Sect. 3. The said European and North American
- 2 Railway Company may extend a branch Railroad from
- 3 some point on their line to the Katahdin Iron Works,
- 4 in the county of Piscataquis, by the way of Brown-
- 5 ville.
- Sect. 4. The European and North American Rail-
- 2 way Company may purchase or lease the line of the
- 3 Aroostook Railroad, with all the stock, rights and
- 4 franchises of said company, or to take the same at the
- 5 cost thereof, with interest at six per cent. per annum,
- 6 at any time, or within one year from the completion
- 7 of the same by the running of cars from Milford to
- 8 Mattawamkeag, and in case the parties cannot agree,
- 9 the matter shall be determined by three commissioners
- 10 appointed by the governor and council on request of
- 11 either party, whose award, or of a majority thereof,
- 12 shall be final and conclusive on the parties; and full
- 13 authority for such sale, lease or transfer, is hereby
- 14 granted to the Aroostook Railroad Company, and all
- 15 the rights and privileges acquired under this act shall

- 16 be enjoyed under the charter of said European and
- 17 North American Railway Company, subject to all the
- 18 duties and liabilities imposed by law upon the company
- 19 whose road shall be so taken or purchased.
 - Sect. 5. Two years are allowed in which to survey
 - 2 and locate the line of the European and North Ameri-
 - 3 can Railway, five years in which to complete the
 - 4 same; and if the European and North American Rail-
 - 5 way Company shall not complete its line of road on or
 - 6 before the thirty-first day of December, A. D. eighteen
 - 7 hundred sixty-five, then this act shall be null and
 - 8 void, except as to such portions of said line as shall
 - 9 have been at that time completed.
 - SECT. 6. This act shall take effect from and after
 - 2 its approval by the governor.
