STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eleven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Sections seventeen and eighteen of the 2 eleventh chapter of the revised statutes, are hereby 3 amended by inserting in each section, after the words 4 "municipal officers," the words "or any justice of 5 the peace."

SECT. 2. Section twenty-six of said chapter is 2 hereby amended by adding to said section the words 3 "and any school district maintaining graded schools 4 may raise money for the support of its schools, as

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5 provided in this section for districts composed of two 6 or more districts."

SECT. 3. Section forty-nine of said chapter is 2 amended by striking out of the twelfth item of said 3 section, the words "if their reports are printed."

SECT. 4. Section sixty-seven of said chapter is 2 amended by substituting for said section the words 3 following: "He shall receive a salary of twelve hun-4 dred dollars, and for travelling and other expenses the 5 sum of four hundred dollars, to be paid quarterly on 6 the first day of April, July, October and January."

SECT. 5. Section six of the normal school act, ap-2 proved March 20, 1860, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
