STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

AN ACT to provide for the defence of the coast and commerce of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Whenever in the judgment of the gov-
- 2 ernor it shall become necessary to protect the coast of
- 3 the state from the invasion of a hostile force, he is
- 4 authorized to procure, equip, officer and man such
- 5 armed vessels as he may think expedient, to cruise
- 6 along the seaboard of the state and act as a coast
- 7 guard to the inhabitants and property thereof.
 - Sect. 2. The relative rank of the officers of said
- 2 armed vessels, their compensation, and the number

- 3 and compensation of the seamen employed in the same,
- 4 shall be fixed by the governor and council.
 - Sect. 3. The sum of three hundred thousand dollars
- 2 is hereby appropriated to carry out the objects of this
- 3 act, and the governor is authorized to draw his war-
- 4 rant for that sum.
 - Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
