STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES relating to the sale of the public lands.

Resolved, That a sale of our public lands would be a
2 wise and an economical measure, and that the gov-
3 ernor and council and the land agent be and they are
4 hereby constituted a board under whose direction said
5 lands may be put into the market for sale, either in
6 the gross or by township or in smaller parcels, as may
7 be deemed most advantageous to the state.

Resolved, That said board are hereby duly empowered
2 to complete the sale or sales of said lands if advan-
3 tageous offers are received for them or any portion of
4 them for cash or undoubted security, and that the land
5 agent is authorized to sign and execute the necessary
6 deeds according to the provisions of section three,
7 chapter five, of the revised statutes.
