STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SIXTY-THREE.

AN ACT to pay bounty to soldiers who may be drafted
into the service of the United States under the late
conscript act of congress.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Every person in this state who shall be
2 drafted into the service of the United States under the
3 late conscription act of congress, and who shall have
4 been mustered into the service of the United States,
5 or furnish a substitute who shall have been mustered
6 into the service of the United States, or pay the com-
7 mutation under the provisions of said act, shall be paid
8 the sum of one hundred dollars.

SECT. 2. The governor is hereby authorized and
2 empowered to adopt such measures as will best accom-
3 plish the purposes of this act, and with the advice of
4 the council draw his warrant upon the treasurer for all
5 expenditures hereby authorized.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved
2 by the governor.
