REPORT.

To the Legislature of Maine:

In compliance with the 5th section of chapter 25 of the public laws of 1861, I submit the following Report:

During the past year I have received from the State Treasurer, for the purchase of books, the sum of eight hundred dollars.

The expenditure for the purchase of books for the same period, has been six hundred nineteen dollars and seventeen cents.

From this statement it will be seen that the amount disbursed has not exhausted the amount appropriated. This result is owing to the fact that the order for missing volumes to complete sets of Reviews, Magazines and Documents, the purchase of which was authorized by the Legislature of 1864, has not been filled.

The volumes are very scarce, and much difficulty has attended the effort to obtain them. The gentleman who has the matter in charge believes that he will soon be able to forward to the Library nearly all the volumes necessary to fill up the broken sets of Reviews, Magazines, &c.

The prosperity of the Library for the past year has exceeded what could be reasonably expected in the distracted state of the country, and the protracted suspension of exchanges with the Southern States. One hundred and six volumes and pamphlets have been added more than in 1863. Several of the donations are quite valuable, as will be seen by the annexed list.

Five volumes have disappeared during the year. The experience of all Librarians shows that it is impossible, unless books are actually under lock and key, to make them absolutely secure. The fact that so few volumes are missing from so large a collection, frequented by so many persons, is rather a matter of surprise. The great exposure of the books renders them liable not only to the depredations of surreptitious borrowers but to great injury from dust and ashes. Entirely unprotected upon the shelves they are quickly

coated with these substances to their great injury. The expense of closing the alcoves with doors and glass windows would be hardly worth considering where property of the State of so much value is involved. The large numbers of important public documents upon the shelves along the south and west walls of the Library Room should also be enclosed in glass cases. The injury to the books is so great that one year's exposure would cost the State more than the total expense.

There are several text-books in the law department that have been superseded; and for the purposes of the Library they are worthless. Besides these, there are many volumes of Annals of Congress, American Archives, and Statutes at Large (pamphlets), that might be sold or exchanged without detriment to the Library.

The newspapers which have been accumulating in the Library for some time past, have been collected and arranged for binding. It is much to be regretted that they have been deemed of such ephemeral consequence that no pains were taken to preserve them. It is desirable, as well for their preservation as for the convenience of reference and care of them, that they should be bound up in separate volumes.

Since the last catalogue was issued, the additions to the Library have amounted to between one and two thousand volumes. This growth, from purchase, exchange and presentation, renders it necessary that addition be made to its catalogue. A supplement to the one now in use, with such improvements on the old as experience may dictate, would be a most valuable assistance to readers in making the contents of the Library more accessible.

I deem it proper in this connection to remark that the Library has nearly outgrown its present accommodations. So large is the increase of volumes in some departments that the shelves are greatly overcrowded, and a portion of them are obliged to be removed to other parts of the Library, separate from those which should naturally stand beside them. Perhaps some means may be devised of obviating this difficulty by increasing the shelf room, or removing a portion to the small room in its rear.

Aside from the small annual appropriation, our chief dependence is placed on the acquisition of books published by authority of Congress, and our exchanges with the several States. To these sources should be added a competent appropriation, to be employed according to a carefully formed plan of expenditure.

There can be no greater mistake than to suppose that a Library can be formed in such manner as to answer the purposes of the State, without a strict attention to method. A carefully formed plan, and a rigid adherence to it, are no less essential to the success of this than any other undertaking.

I express my confident reliance on the readiness of the Legislature to make ample provision for the improvement in the Library, which, it is believed, is an object of increasing interest to the people of the State.
