### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and fifty-one, section one, of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four, relating to poll taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and
- 2 fifty-one of the public laws of the year one thousand
- 3 eight hundred and sixty-four, is hereby amended by
- 4 striking out the word "two" in the last line of said
- 5 section and inserting in its place the word "three"; so
- 6 that the provision in this section as amended shall read
- 7 as follows, viz: one sixth part, as nearly as may be,
- 8 of the whole sum to be raised; but the whole poll tax

- 9 assessed in one year upon an individual for town,
- 10 county and state purposes, except highway taxes sep-
- 11 arately assessed, shall not exceed three dollars.
  - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
