STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to abolish the February term of the supreme judicial court for the county of Knox, and to change the time of holding the April term of said court for said county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The February term of the supreme judi-
- 2 cial court for the county of Knox is hereby abolished.
 - Sect. 2. The supreme judicial court for said county
- 2 shall hereafter be holden on the first Tuesday of April,
- 3 annually, instead of the third Tuesday of April, as is
- 4 now provided by law.
 - SECT. 3. All writs, petitions, orders, decrees, cer-
- 2 tificates, reports, warrants, complaints, appeals, in-

- 3 dictments, and all matters and processes of every kind,
- 4 civil and criminal, commenced for, pending in, or re-
- 5 turnable to said court, and which would, but for the
- 6 provisions of this act, have day at the term of said
- 7 court to be held on the second Tuesday of February of
- 8 the present year, as by law provided, shall be return-
- 9 able to, and have day at the term of said court to be
- 10 held on the first Tuesday of April of the current year.
 - Sect. 4. All writs, petitions, orders, decrees, cer-
 - 2 tificates, reports, warrants, complaints, appeals, in-
 - 3 dictments, and all matters and processes of every kind,
 - 4 civil and criminal, commenced for, pending in, or re-
 - 5 turnable to said court, and which would, but for the
- 6 provisions of this act, have day at the term of said
- '7 court to be held on the third Tuesday of April of the
- 8 present year, as by law provided, shall be returnable
- 9 to, and have day at the term of said court to be held
- 10 on the first Tuesday of April of the current year.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
