STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend "an act to secure the proper expenditure of school moneys in the Madawaska townships."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The first section of chapter two hundred 2 fifty-one, special laws of eighteen hundred sixty-three, 3 is hereby amended by adding the words "together 4 with XVI in the seventh, otherwise known as Eagle 5 Lake plantation," to the clause ending with "ninth 6 ranges inclusive."

SECT. 2. The words "irrespective of the payment 2 of any state tax," which were stricken from section 3 seven, of same chapter, by an amendment, chapter

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4 three hundred twenty, special acts of eighteen hun-5 dred sixty-four, are hereby restored.

SECT. 3. The eighth section of said act is amended 2 so as to read, "Such agent shall receive in compensa-3 tion for his services one dollar a day and travelling 4 expenses, to be paid from the treasury on the gov-5 ernor's warrant, when audited and approved by the 6 council.

SECT. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent 2 with this act, are hereby repealed; and this act shall 3 take effect when approved by the governor.
