STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to unassigned naval and marine credits.

Resolved, That the adjutant general is hereby directed
2 to make no more assignments of men upon the quotas
3 of cities, towns or plantations out of any credits for
4 unassigned men who have enlisted into the naval or
5 marine service of the government, and who have been
6 passed to the credit of this state by the general gov-
7 ernment ; but such credits shall be assigned to the
8 credit of the cities, towns and plantations pro rata
9 according to their enrolment lists ; but no town which
10 has bought any of these credits, and has been allowed
11 for the same upon its quota, shall be entitled to any
12 share in such assignment.
