IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to tax dogs.

Be it enacted by the Sena'e and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. All male dogs more than six months old
- 2 shall be taxed one dollar; and all female dogs more
- 3 than six months old shall be taxed three dollars in the
- 4 city, town or plantation wherein they are kept, on the
- 5 first day of April in each year, to owners or persons
- 6 having them in charge at that time.
 - Sect. 2. All persons owning or having in charge
- 2 dogs more than six months old shall, on or before the
- 3 first day of April in each year, return such animal or
- 4 animals to the assessors of cities, towns or plantations
- 5 for taxation.

- SECT. 3. All persons neglecting or refusing to so
- 2 return such animal or animals to assessors of cities,
- 3 towns or plantations, shall forfeit the sum of ten dol-
- 4 lars, to be recovered by complaint; one-half to go to
- 5 complainant, and the other half to city, town or plan-
- 6 tation in which the complaint is brought.
- SECT. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with 2 this act are hereby repealed.
 - SECT. 5. This act takes effect when approved.
