STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of idiotic persons.

Resolved, That the governor and council be, and are
2 hereby authorized to provide for the education of a
3 limited number of idiotic children, in the same manner
4 as that of the deaf and dumb and blind, at institutions
5 in other states, and that they apportion for their sup-
6 port any money that may be appropriated in aid of
7 said beneficiaries, as they (the governor and council)
8 may think proper.

Resolved, That in granting aid to state beneficiaries,
2 supported at institutions in other states, the indigent,
3 and those whose protectors have fallen in defence of
4 the country, should be regarded as having the highest
5 claim to the assistance of the state.
