STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of idiotic persons.

Resolved, That the governor and council be, and are

- 2 hereby authorized to provide for the education of a
- 3 limited number of idiotic children, in the same manner
- 4 as that of the deaf and dumb and blind, at institutions
- 5 in other states, and that they apportion for their sup-
- 6 port any money that may be appropriated in aid of
- 7 said beneficiaries, as they (the governor and council)
- 8 may think proper.

Resolved, That in granting aid to state beneficiaries,

- 2 supported at institutions in other states, the indigent,
- 3 and those whose protectors have fallen in defence of
- 4 the country, should be regarded as having the highest
- 5 claim to the assistance of the state.
