### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter nine of the public laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, concerning the exemption of sewing machines from attachment and execution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter nine of the public laws of eigh-
- 2 teen hundred and sixty-one, entitled an act to exempt
- 3 certain property from attachment and execution, is
- 4 hereby amended by striking out the word "fifty" in
- 5 the third line and substituting the words "one hun-
- 6 dred" therefor, so that said act, when amended, shall
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 In addition to the property now exempted by law

- 9 from attachment, sale or levy on execution, there shall
- 10 be exempted one sewing machine of a value not ex-
- 11 ceeding one hundred dollars, held for actual use by
- 12 any debtor or the family of any debtor.
  - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on its approval.
