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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and one, entitled writ for replevyng a person, and chapter one hundred and thirty-five, entitled sentence and its execution in criminal cases, and the liberation of poor convicts, of the revised statutes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section third of chapter one hundred and 2 one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by in- 3 serting in the third line, after the word "sheriff," the 4 words "or his deputy."

SECT. 2. Section ten of chapter one hundred and 2 thirty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended .

3 by inserting between the word “to” and the word  
4 “and,” in the seventh line, the following words:  
5 “which oath may be administered by the sheriff, jailer,  
6 or any justice of the peace or trial justice.”
